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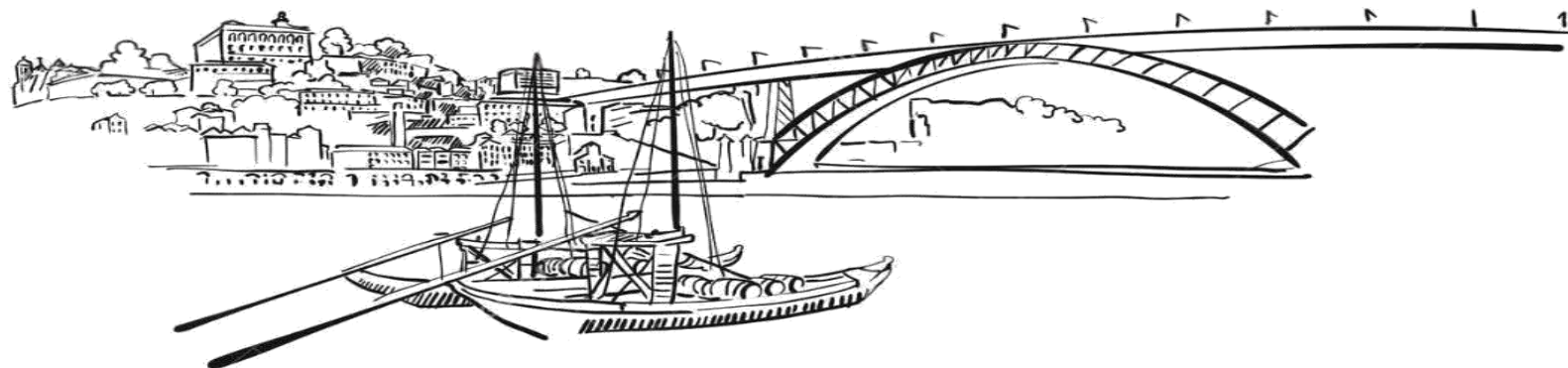

13th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ISAPL – WELCOME LETTER

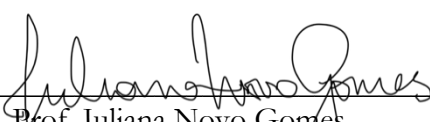

The **13th International Congress of the International Society of Applied Psycholinguistics (ISAPL 2026)** will take place from **11 to 13 June 2026**, with a Pre-Congress (10 June) and Post-Congress (14 June) with academic and social activities, bringing together researchers, faculty members, and students from around the world to discuss recent developments in the field of Applied Psycholinguistics and related areas. **ISAPL 2026** aims to foster interdisciplinary exchange and provide a dynamic forum for both **established scholars and early-career researchers**, strengthening international collaboration in the field of Applied Psycholinguistics.

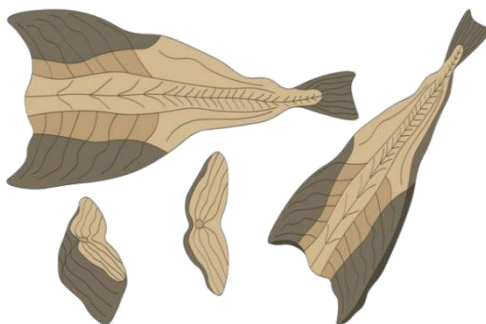

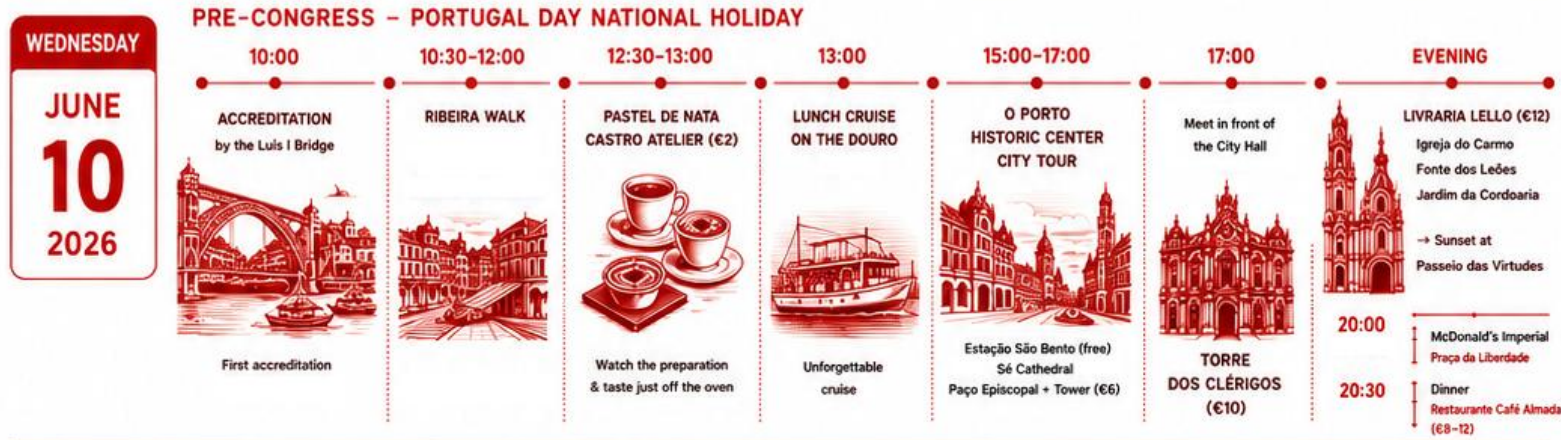
13th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ISAPL – SOCIAL PROGRAMME

Beyond the scientific sessions, these moments are intended to foster dialogue, collegiality, and cultural exchange among participants, allowing everyone to experience both the academic spirit of ISAPL and the unique atmosphere of Porto. Throughout the Congress, the ‘Coffee-break with Posters’, held on three moments on the second floor of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities of the University of Porto, will provide opportunities for interaction between presenters and participants.

These informal encounters are often where new collaborations begin. A simple question such as, “What is your research about, and how might it relate to applied psycholinguistics?” can open friendly conversations, after all, researchers are always enthusiastic to share their work and ideas. During the Congress days, participants are invited to enjoy a series of cultural and social gatherings. These activities are designed not only to showcase the cultural identity of Porto, but also to strengthen the sense of community that has always characterized the International Congresses of ISAPL. Most images in this Book of Programme have a link to the official website of the place or to the Google Maps location. Please understand that the programme may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances, holiday schedule, and weather conditions. Bring a light jacket as evenings can be cooler, especially by the river.

"Silêncio, que se vai cantar o fado". In Portugal, remaining completely silent during a Fado performance is considered a profound gesture of respect toward the singer and the music itself. Avoid whispering or speaking while the Fado is being performed — attentive silence is part of the tradition and allows the emotion and poetry of the song to be fully experienced.





The social programme activities begins during the **Pre-Congress, Wednesday, June 10, 2026.**

As this date coincides with *Portugal Day National Holiday*, some places are closed (ex., *Casa do Infante*, *Palácio da Bolsa*), but most places will be open at the historic center. Wear comfortable footwear, always be hydrated, bring sunglasses and sunscreen. Down at Ribeira, we spend the morning and afternoon on a citytour at O Porto historic center.

At **10:00**, we have the first accreditation for the participants at the *Ponte Pensil Bar*, by the iconic *Luís I Bridge*, followed by optional walks through Ribeira. You can ride the *Funicular dos Guindais* (one way or up-and-down) along the medieval *Muralhas Fernandinas*, starting the tour backwards, visiting the uphill *Igreja Santa Clara* (€0) and *Sé do Porto* (€0). To truly visit the historical landmarks, there is a combined ticket to enter the Cloister and tower of *Sé Cathedral* plus *Paço Episcopal* (€6), taking a worthy one hour visit.

At **11:00**, for those that stayed down at *Ponte Pensil Bar*, start with a walk at Ribeira along River Douro. Good place to buy souvenirs. A must thing to do is to watch at *Castro Atelier* the preparation of *Pastel de Nata* and eat one right off the oven (€2) (dust them generously with powdered sugar and cinnamon), with coffee or *ginjinha*. Admire the 20.000 tiles with the history of the North of Portugal at *Estação São Bento*. At the station, you can grab something at *Time Out Market Porto*. Take your time to visit the *Sé Cathedral*.

At **13:00**, we have an unforgettable *Cruise at Douro River* (€18). At **15:00**, for an afternoon coffee, we may choose to have a *Pastel de Nata* at the beautiful *Café Majestic* (€9) or at *Confeitaria do Bolhão* (€3–6). You can buy things for a picnic at the *Mercado do Bolhão*. Don't miss the *Ginjinha Mariquinhas* (€2). Nearby, take photos at the beautiful blue tiles of *Capela das Almas de Santa Catarina*.

Meet at **16:00** at Aliados Avenue, in front of the PORTO sign at *Câmara Municipal do Porto*. Another good place to buy souvenirs. Visit the *Igreja da Santíssima Trindade*, the biggest in Porto. Do not forget to eat a *Pastel de Nata* at *Manteigaria* (€2).

At **16:30** climb *Torre dos Clérigos* (€10) for a great view of the city. Visit the *Livraria Lello* (€12 book on advance), one of the most beautiful libraries in the world, with an amazing red staircase. Take some photos at *Igreja do Carmo* and at *Fonte dos Leões* in front of the *Reitoria of Universidade do Porto*. Walk along the *Jardim da Cordoaria* to *Passeio das Virtudes* to watch an unforgettable sunset at around **17:30**. You can extend *Passeio das Virtudes* at *Bosco Bar*.

For a quick dinner, **19:30**, eat at *McDonald's Imperial*, at *Praça da Liberdade*, the most beautiful McDonald's in the world. Nearby, at **20:30**, have a proper dinner at *Restaurante Café Almada* (€8–12), where you can eat a wide variety of typical Portuguese cuisine or a Brazilian Picanha.



After all the symposia of the **first day of the Congress, Thursday, June 11, 2026**, we meet at **17:00** to watch the sunset at Crystal Palace Gardens (closes at 19:00) for a *Porto d'Honra* reception. 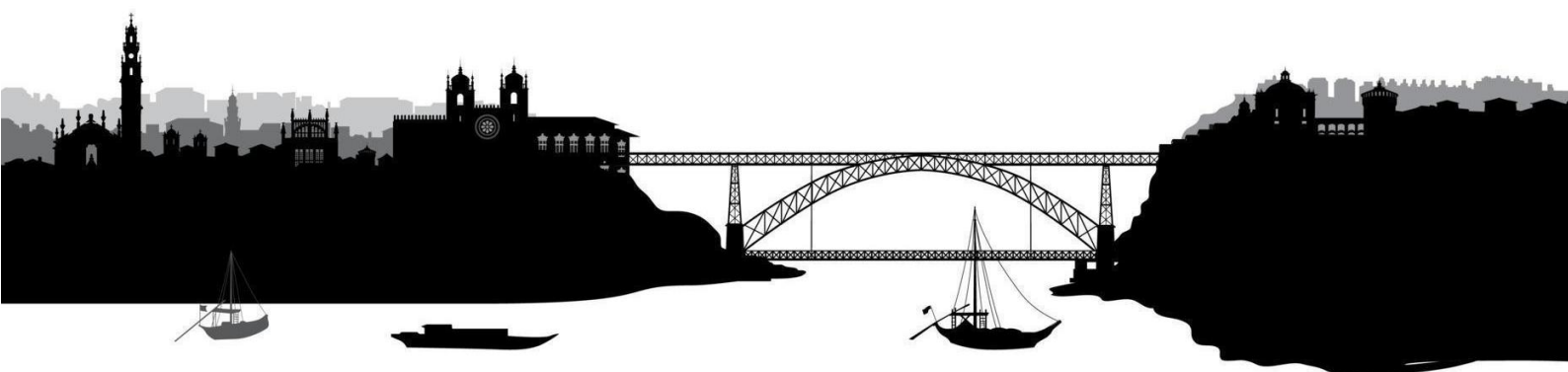
